Course Language: The courses are normally conducted in English or Arabic, but can be made available in a variety of languages. If you are not fluent in the above two languages please enquire before applying.

General Info: Our Course Directors and IDC Staff Instructors conduct IDC programmes several times a year. In addition, Instructor continuing education programmes are available in Hurghada at any time. Due to the high quality instruction and our low student-to-instructor ratios, our instructor candidates traditionally gain above average scores in the IE in all areas of evaluation.

The Instructor Development Course (IDC) consists of two parts:

- 1) The Assistant Instructor (AI) course and
- 2) The Open Water Scuba Instructor (OWSI) programme.

The combination of the 4-day AI course and the 5-day OWSI programme makes up the continuous 9-day IDC. It is possible to complete the AI course and then complete the OWSI later. This might be interesting for the candidate who doesn't have the time to complete the full IDC, or feels the need to have more diving experience before completing the OWSI with us. It is also possible for those AI candidates who have already completed the new AI course at another facility to enrol in our OWSI programme.

Instructors from other training organizations may qualify for the OWSI part depending on their teaching experience.

Prerequisites:

Assistant Instructor Course/Instructor Development Course

- Be a certified PADI Divemaster or hold a leadership level certification with another recreational diver training organization
- Have a medical clearance, signed by a physician, not older than 12 months.
- Submit verification of CPR and First Aid training within the past 24 months.
- Show proof of 60 dives including deep dives, night dives and underwater navigation.
- Certified diver for at least six months.

Open Water Scuba Instructor Programme

- Have completed the new PADI AI course or be an instructor with a recognized training organization for at least 6 months (PADI list of equivalencies).
- Have a medical clearance, signed by a physician, not older than 12 months.
- Submit verification of CPR and first aid training within the past 24 months.
- Show proof of 60 dives including deep dives, night dives and underwater navigation. .
- Certified diver for at least six months.

Instructor Examination

- Have successfully completed an IDC within the last 12 months.
- Show proof of 100 dives including deep dives, night dives and underwater navigation.
- Certified diver for at least six months.
- Submit a medical completed and signed by a physician within the last 12 months.
- Be a current Emergency First Response Instructor.

Emergency First Response Instructor

- Have completed an EFR Primary and Secondary course within the past 24 months.

Specialty Instructor/Master Scuba Diver Trainer Prep (5 Instructor Specialties)

- Be a renewed PADI AI or Instructor or have successfully completed an IDC or OWSI within the last 12 months – details on request.

IDC Staff Instructor Course

- Be a current PADI Master Scuba Diver Trainer.

Beneficial Preparation for the PADI Instructor Development Course (IDC)

The PADI IDC is a very intensive course, which prepares you for the Instructor Examination (IE). It also covers aspects beyond the IE that will assist you in becoming a knowledgeable practicing professional.

We are a very experienced Training Facility with more than 1000 successful IE-Candidates. Over the years we noticed that participants had problems when they arrived here with insufficient preparation. They had to work harder during the IDC than other candidates because they had to learn things which they should have known already. As a result task loading and a higher degree of stress followed.

The question that arises is: **What is a good preparation?**

To answer this question let's have a look at the **IE areas of evaluation**:

1a) PADI System, Standards and Procedures

This part will be covered during the IDC. Do not try to learn all the Standards there are. That is not necessary at all. Your preparation will be in having an **updated Instructor Manual**. Contact us for update details or check the PADI Training Bulletins. You should know which sections the Instructor Manual contains and how to find them.

1b) Five Dive Theory Sections

Prepare your diving knowledge. You will be evaluated in five topics: **Physics, Physiology, Equipment, Skills and Environment and the Recreational Dive Planner (RDP)**, the Table and now also the eRDP/ML.

One big misconception of some candidates is that they will learn these topics within the IDC. This is basically wrong. All these dive theory subjects have previously been covered in the Divemaster programme. It is not part of the IDC curriculum. We will test that particular knowledge, we provide feedback and our Staff also gives remediation. However, do not expect to be taught in these areas in its entirety.

A very good preparation is the **Diving Knowledge Workbook**, which you should be familiar with from your Divemaster training. If you are able to give the right answers and explain why the other options are wrong, there is nothing you have to worry about in the IE. Back up your knowledge with the Encyclopaedia, but do not try to learn the whole book word for word!

2) Knowledge Development Presentations

Teaching Presentations will be covered in detail during the Assistant Instructor course and practiced more in the Open Water Instructor programme. It helps to be familiar with the Student Manuals and Instructor Outlines of the Open Water Diver course, the Adventures in Diving programme, the new Rescue Diver course and the Divemaster course.

3a) Confined Water Teaching Presentations

During the Assistant Instructor course you will learn how to teach effectively in confined water. During the IE you will be asked to present one skill from the Open Water Diver course. Watching the **PADI Open Water Diver DVD** would be helpful to refresh yourself. Also rescue skills will now be included in the IDC and IE; therefore it would be a good idea to review the **Rescue Diver DVD**.

3b) Confined Water Skill Circuit

Review the confined water training skills of the Open Water Diver course.

A helpful tool is the **PADI Open Water Diver DVD**. There you can see these skills in demonstration quality. The same Evaluation Criteria are used as with your Divemaster course.

4a) Open Water Teaching Presentations

Be familiar with the Open Water Diver and new Rescue Diver course in particular. Skills from some Adventure Dives are now included in the IDC and IE as well, particularly Search and Recovery (knot tying and lift bag use), Underwater Navigation and Peak Performance Buoyancy.

4b) Open Water Rescue Demonstration

Especially if it has been a while since your Rescue Diver and/or Divemaster course, it will be necessary to review parts of the Rescue Diver course. You will have to demonstrate proficiency in Rescue Exercise 7 'Unresponsive Diver at the Surface'. A good idea would be to watch the **DVD** and practice again. Proficiency in mouth-to-mouth and mouth-to-pocket mask ventilation is expected and will be evaluated in the IE.

5) General Skills

Don't miss the opportunity to go diving whenever possible to improve your general diving skills.

6) Swim Test

One evaluation part is the 800 m snorkel swim. Although it is not timed and there are generally no problems, it requires a certain degree of fitness. Obviously swimming with mask, snorkel and fins, using your fins only and face down, is the ideal preparation.

These are suggestions, which arise out of experience and should be followed.

Of course you can also be successful without completing all these suggested training preparations. It might be a bit harder, though. The more preparation you can do in advance, the easier and more fun the IDC will be for you!
