To make your course even more enjoyable the Red Sea diving season is year-round with visibility averaging 30m (100'). Water temperatures range from 20°C (70°F) in the winter months to 29°C (88°F) in summer. The topside air temperatures range between 22°C (74°F) in winter to 38°C (106°F) in summer. Winter months are usually accompanied by a breeze. Divers can use DARLEX, POLARTEC or 3 mm suits during late spring,

summer and early autumn. During winter divers usually bring a 5mm two-piece suit to remain comfortable. For outside activities bring light clothing and don't forget your swimsuit, suntan lotion and sunglasses. For winter evenings a light sweater or a jacket is recommended.
